The Nottawaseppi Huron Band of the Potawatomi (NHBP) is implementing a family-focused project through funding provided by the Administration for Children and Families—Administration for Native Americans grant number 90NI0019. In addition to other project goals, the NHBP Tribe has designed its activities to empower parents in their parenting role and improve the parenting skills of NHBP Tribal Members.

Partnerships of this Project include Parenting Awareness Michigan, Family Nurturing Center of Michigan, and the Citizen Potawatomi Nation. Although only eligible participants of this Project are NHBP Tribal Members, the Tribe welcomes interested persons to contact us as a resource for important parenting information and materials that will help make families healthier.
