2. National Impaired Driving Prevention Month

- December is recognized as National Impaired Driving Prevention Month. Drunk driving crashes increase throughout the month of December as more people travel and attend events where alcohol is served. Alcohol and drugs - including opioids, marijuana, and some over-the-counter medications - can impair driving by causing drowsiness, altering visual functions, and affect mental judgment and motor skills.


