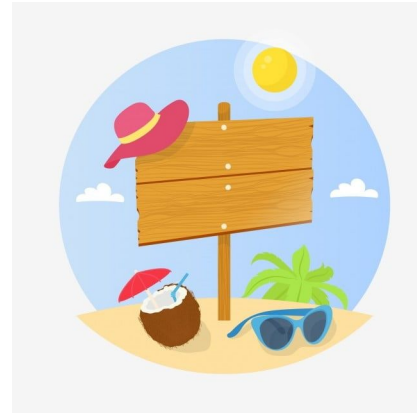

2. The Truth Initiative Tobacco/Vape-Free College Program

- The Truth Initiative is offering another round of tobacco/vape-free college grants of up to \$20,000 to colleges and universities to support the adoption and implementation of a 100% tobacco/vape-free policy. Colleges that have smoke or tobacco-free policies that do not include e-cigarettes may still apply. To combat the vaping public health crisis, Truth Initiative is offering grants of up to \$10,000 to colleges to strengthen their 100% smoke or tobacco-free policies by adding e-cigarettes.

5. Drug Abuse Warning Network (DAWN): Findings from Drug-Related Emergency Department Visits, 2022

- The DAWN 2022 Findings on Drug-Related Emergency Related Visits presents national estimates of drug-related emergency department (ED) visits. In 2022, there were an estimated total of 714,521 drug-related ED visits in the United States. [The DAWN data](#) were analyzed to generate nationally representative weighted estimates of 1) for all drug-related ED visits, 2) for the top drugs involved in drug-related ED visits, 3) for different opioid types involved in ED visits, 4) to describe polysubstance in ED visits, and 5) the identification of newly mentioned drugs in 2022.
