How Schools Can Use Results

Planning

- Identify needs and trends
- Data to support observed behaviors
- Environmental Scan – what is in place to address needs
- Emergency Operations Planning – identified needs can become physical safety issues (i.e. bullying or drug use)

Partnering

- District behavioral health professionals (counselors, psychologists, nurses)
- Mental health & recovery boards, prevention agencies, health departments, job and family services, law enforcements

Implementation

- Universal, Selected, and Indicated behavioral health interventions
- Behavioral health impacts student growth and academic achievement
- Safety and Violence Prevention Training
